It's hard to believe that another school year has come and gone! Thanks to all of you, *Our Loyal Supporters*, it has been an amazing growth year for our charity with big increases to the number of kids that we were able to help.

This past school year, "Clothing our Kids" has grown to a network of **32** Sussex County Elementary Schools serviced by **150** unpaid volunteers. As far as the kids go, **2,552** children received **12,546** pieces of clothing. **Thank you for your generosity!** And yet, there is still more work to be done - we pray that we will never have to say no to a child that needs our help.

The "Chicks For Charity" recently held a fundraiser at a local restaurant. The event was a sell-out and the gals were able to raise more than double the amount anticipated.
